- Metadata management

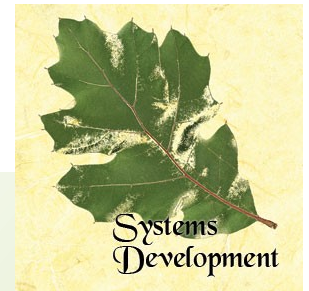
